- Review and sign the parent and cheerleader constitutions with your child and
 be sure they understand there will be consequences for unacceptable behaviors. Athletes
 and parents must abide by the Creekview Competition Cheerleading Constitution
 throughout the school year.
- Teach your child to be responsible and punctual by helping them be on time in appropriate attire with all required items.
- Enthusiastically attend athletic functions to show your support. Parents are expected to sit together to cheer on all Creekview Cheerleading teams and display positive sportsmanship towards other teams.
- **Read and respond to all emails** (when applicable) that concern your cheerleader.

- **Refrain from expressing** *any* **negativity** regarding Creekview High School, Creekview Cheerleading, or Georgia High School Association on social media or in the community.
- **Participate** in all fundraising activities.
- **Volunteer** in areas where you can make a difference so we can keep the program running effectively. Volunteering is mandatory at various fundraising events and in the program committees. (We cannot run this program without parent/family volunteers).
- **Respect the competition** and all officials regardless of the outcome.
- **Learn and understand the scoring system** so you can help know areas of growth for your athlete and the Creekview Cheer Program.
- Parent/Cheerleader concerns and individual coach meetings must be scheduled in advance and not during practice. When communicating/requesting a meeting with coaches, parents/cheerleaders must include the team head coach in all communication and allow 2 business days for a response.
- **Seek out information from the Booster Club Board** only with information that pertains to their position. Save all coaching questions/concerns for the coaches.
- Live, Encourage and Embody Family. Help all fans, supporters and extended family understand our motto #Familyon3 through your actions and guidance. Support all Creekview athlete's endeavors.
